



Environmental Improvements for Individuals with with Asthma and COPD



Is a member of your family with asthma waking at night? Is their medication just not taking care of their symptoms? A home assessment may be helpful.



The American Lung Association is able to offer FREE home assessments virtually and in person.

What is a home assessment?

An American Lung Association staff member will walk through a person's home, virtually or in person, and offer suggestions of how to reduce the allergens and irritants that may be making their lung disease worse.

The American Lung Association can then provide supplies to reduce these allergens and irritants in the home.

There is no charge for this program. It is completely free for individuals with asthma or COPD.

The person will be contacted again at 3 and 12 months to complete a survey to see if there have been any changes to their health. This will help us determine the usefulness of the program.

What happens after the home assessment?

The American Lung Association will provide FREE products to help reduce exposure to asthma and COPD triggers. We will also provide education about creating a lung healthy home.
