- Technical Assistance for providers on EMR adoption and Meaningful Use attestation (1700 providers from 606xx zipcode)
- Development of Health Information Specialist Role
- Housed at Northwestern University within Center for Health Information Partnerships

Sustainability (2015-present)

- Capitalize on Health Information Specialist and existing relationships developed with practices
- Expand to support quality improvement activities and change management

Medicaid MU HelpDesk (2014-present)

- State-funded program to support Medicaid providers with MU needs
- Supported 12,000 providers in the last year

Healthy Hearts in the Heartland (2015-present)

- Research study on QI resources and facilitation to small practices.
- Supporting 225 practices

Great Lakes Practice Transformation Network (2015- present)

- CMS Transforming Clinical Practice Initiative (TCPi)
- Consortia of Indiana, Illinois, Michigan, Ohio, and Kentucky
- Engaged with 4,500 providers in Illinois
- Seek improvements in clinical quality, population health, clinical efficiencies

• Support practices with <15 providers with MIPS



GLPTN Change Tactics

- Patient and Family Centered Care
 - Patient and family engagement; team-based care; population management; practice as a community partner; coordinated care delivery; organized, evidence-based care; enhanced access
- Continuous, Data-driven quality improvement
 - Engaged committed leadership; QI strategy supporting culture of quality and safety; transparent measurement and monitoring; optimal use of HIT;
- Sustainable Business Operations
 - Strategic use of practice revenue; workforce vitality and joy in practice; capability to analyze and document value; efficiency of operation
